OAKLAWN TRAINERS' INCENTIVE PROGRAM

DECEMBER 2025 – MAY 2026 RACING SEASON

- Oaklawn and the Arkansas HBPA will honor Thoroughbred trainers with a Trainers' Reward.
- Beginning Friday, December 12, 2025 (the first day of the Oaklawn racing season) and continuing through Saturday, May 2, 2026, trainers will be eligible to receive (i.e., will accrue) a \$250 Participation Bonus for each official starter in a non-stakes race at Oaklawn finishing fourth (4th) through last in the final race result.
- In order for the trainer to earn and receive (i.e., in order for the trainer to be paid) the trainer's accumulated Participation Bonuses, the trainer must have at least one (1) official starter in any race at Oaklawn during the last eight (8) racing days of the December 2025 – May 2026 Oaklawn racing season.
- Participation Bonus checks for Participation Bonuses earned and payable in accordance with this program will be deposited into trainers' accounts in the Horsemen's Bookkeepers' office after the end of the December 2025 – May 2026 Oaklawn Racing Season (i.e., after May 2, 2026), and on or before May 18, 2026.
- No Participation Bonus will be accrued or awarded for any horse that is unable to start for any reason.
- The Participation Bonus payments shall be made from the portion of the purse fund generated by horse racing (other than the portion of the purse fund from monies required by applicable law to be used only for purses).
- An eligibility committee consisting of the State Steward, the President of AR HBPA, and Oaklawn VP of Racing shall have the authority to monitor the program for integrity, and to deny and rescind Participation Bonus(es), where the eligibility committee finds that the trainer entered horse(s) that clearly should not have been entered under the circumstances merely in order to receive the Participation Bonus, or otherwise took clearly inappropriate actions in bad faith to wrongfully affect the accrual or payment of any Participation Bonus contrary to the purposes and intent of the program. The eligibility committee shall grant the trainer fair opportunity for a hearing prior to rendering any final decision to deny or rescind any Participation Bonus to which the trainer would have otherwise been entitled to receive.
- AR HBPA board members and Oaklawn management will each evaluate the program after May 2, 2026, to determine whether they both desire to continue the program during the next racing season; and if so, any mutually agreed revisions to the terms of the program.

It is the responsibility of each trainer to make certain the correct sex and ownership of each horse is on the foal papers or digital certificates. Trainers are subject to fines.

No horse may be entered in more than one race on the same day. No more than two horses of the same interest shall be entered in any one purse or overnight event. However, if a race is divided each half shall be considered as a separate race.

Every entry in a purse race must be in the name of a person having ownership in the horse, and the full name of every person having ownership in a horse, or, excepting the trainer's percent, and interest in its winnings, must be registered with the racing secretary, as must be every change in such ownership or interest thereafter made during the meeting.

Oaklawn Jockey Club, in order to present the best program possible, reserves the right to divide any race in the condition book or use an extra race before using a substitute race.

Horses penalized in a race shall not be entitled to any of the allowances in such race. Horses not entitled to first allowance in a race are not entitled to second, and if not the second, then to no subsequent allowance. Winners or non-winners stated sum means winner or non-winner of a single race of that value to the first-place horse.

The maximum number of starters in any race shall be limited to the number of starting positions afforded by the starting gate. The maximum number of starters shall further be limited by the number of horses which, in the opinion of the stewards, considering the safety of horses and riders, can be afforded a fair and equal start.

If the number of entries in any purse race exceeds the number of horses permitted to start, starters shall be determined by lot in the presence of those making the entries and post positions shall be in order in which they are drawn. The same method shall be employed in determining starters and post positions in races that are divided.

Handicap (stakes and overnight) preferences will be given to high weights. In allowance stakes, if the number of entries exceeds the limitation of the Oaklawn starting gate, preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings.

A fully paid entry in a stakes race, when denied the opportunity of starting because the number of entries exceeds the capacity of the Oaklawn starting gate, will be entitled to a refund of the nomination and/or entry box fee. Oaklawn reserves the right to change or withdraw any unclosed race.

No entry shall be received of any horse not stabled on the Oaklawn grounds, unless it's stabling elsewhere has been approved by the racing secretary.

No entry will be received except upon the condition that all disputes, claims and objections arising out of the racing or with respect to interpretation of the conditions of any race shall be decided by the stewards and their decision upon all points shall be final.

The entries of any person, or the transfer of any entry, may be refused with or without either notice or reason being given.

The franchise holder, with permission from the stewards, shall have the right to refuse acceptance of any nomination to any stakes race, and to revoke any previously accepted nomination, for any reason. If a nomination is denied or revoked, all nomination fees tendered or paid with respect to the horse for its nomination for such race shall be returned to the owner of the horse whose nomination was denied or revoked. Denial or refusal to allow a horse to enter or start because of race being postponed or cancelled; overfill of entries; failure to satisfy any eligibility condition; scratch by stewards for horse's actions in paddock, during warm-up, or in starting gate (including breaking through the gate), scratch by stewards on advice of track veterinarian, or scratch by stewards for violation of any other rule, shall not be grounds for refund of any fees.

In all overnight races, winners are preferred unless otherwise specified.

UNCOUPLED SAME OWNER ENTRIES

UNCOUPLING OF SAME OWNER ENTRIES IN CLAIMING RACES \$20,000 AND ABOVE, MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT, ALLOWANCE AND STAKES RACES. (In races that overfill, trainers must declare preference of runners at time of entry. Same owner second choice horses will be least preferred.)

RUN BACK POLICY

A HORSE THAT STARTS IN A RACE LESS THAN NINE (9) DAYS AFTER THE HORSE'S LAST START (i.e., WITH LESS THAN NINE (9) DAYS REST), MAY NOT **START** IN A RACE AT OAKLAWN FOR A PERIOD OF FOURTEEN (14) DAYS AFTER STARTING WITH LESS THAN NINE (9) DAYS REST. This house rule may be modified, suspended or revoked by Oaklawn at any time.

SPECIAL WEIGHT ALLOWANCES

THE ALLOWANCES BELOW ARE PROGRAMMED TO BE TAKEN UNLESS TRAINER WAIVES THE WEIGHT AT THE TIME OF ENTRY.

In all overnight races at this meeting at a distance of one mile or more, the following allowance may be claimed without respect to other allowances (except maiden allowance). For horses that have never won a race at a mile or over: Two-year-old and upwards allowed 3 lbs. Weight allowances for Arkansas-breds in non-Arkansas-Bred races, excepting Stakes Races: Three-year-olds and upward allowed 5 pounds.

PREFERENCE DATE

Preference dates will not supersede conditions of a race. Horses will not be eligible to receive a date until their papers or digital certifications with valid Coggins are on file in the racing office. All horses registered prior to **NOON, Tuesday, Dec. 2, 2025** will receive a zero (0), which is the lowest possible date. A horse keeps his zero until he runs; scratches, or the papers are removed from the office. All horses registering after **NOON, Tuesday, Dec. 2, 2025** will receive a one (1) or preference corresponding to the entry day of the meeting when registered. A zero has first preference.

Preference dates are good at any distance. Horses that run or have the opportunity to run will receive a preference corresponding to the date they race and lose all dates previously held. This excludes stakes and handicaps. Horses which scratch or are scratched will keep their preference as if they had run. An up-to-date preference list will be made available after the overnight list is out. Any omissions, discrepancies, errors, etc. must be lodged prior to the next drawing of entries.

All horses placed on the Stewards', Veterinarians' or Starter's lists will be posted on the bulletin board. They will not be permitted to run until they have been approved. Horses which have established a date at the current meeting will lose their preference should their papers be withdrawn from the racing office or demonstrate intent to race elsewhere and must reestablish a preference date at this meeting. Should a horse's papers be withdrawn from the racing office for just cause, (i.e. tattoo, corrections, change of ownership, or clarification, etc.) the racing secretary may determine the status of the preference date established.

In no way does the claiming, ownership transfer or trainer transfer of a horse affect the preference date.

When a horse's name appears in a race, other than a Stakes, and is entered for the following day, such entry must have permission from the racing secretary and will be given no consideration should the race in which it is entered be overfilled. It is the responsibility of a person making an entry to claim preference at time of entry. The stewards will consider no claims that do not comply with the above regulations.

Any registered Arkansas-bred horse which is entered and runs in a non-restricted (open) race will be allowed to retain the preference date received either from most recent Arkansas-bred restricted race or if unraced at the current meet, the date when registration papers were filed with Oaklawn racing office.

Any registered Arkansas-bred horse which is entered and subsequently scratched from a non-restricted (open) race shall receive the new preference date corresponding to date of the race from which it was scratched.

ELIGIBILITY

Oaklawn will not allot stall space or accept entries of horses which raced for a claiming price less than \$5,000 unless they thereafter have finished first, second, third or fourth for \$5,000 or more. No maiden three-year-olds and up which has started for a claiming price of less than \$7,500 unless it has subsequently finished second, third or fourth for \$7,500 or more will be eligible to start or be granted stall space. However, no horse can run itself ineligible at the Oaklawn meet.

No first time starter maidens six (6) years of age or older will be eligible.

No horses age 10 and older unless expressly approved by the Racing Secretary and Stewards.
No foals of 2024 will be permitted on the grounds.

Trainers must name a rider by the time of draw. A rider can be named on only one horse in a race unless second horse is part of a coupled entry. Failure to name a rider will require the stewards or an appointee to select one. The same rider may be named on both parts of an entry and remain on, with the Steward's permission, until 10 a.m. on RACE DAY. At that time both parts of the entry shall have different riders or one part of entry scratched.

PURSE DISTRIBUTION

ARC HR 2260. Purse distribution

(a) Stakes races. In stakes races, 2.5% of the purse shall be paid with respect to each of the official starters 6th through last in the final race result; and the balance of the purse shall be paid: winner 60%; place 20%; show 10%; fourth 6%; and fifth 4%. For example, in a stakes race with twelve (12) official starters and a \$200,000 purse: 6th through 12th would each receive \$5,000 (i.e., 2.5% each, for a total of \$35,000); and the remaining

\$165,000 would then be paid out 60% (\$99,000) to the winner; 20% (\$33,000) to second; 10% (\$16,500) to third; 6% (\$9,900) to fourth; and 4% (\$6,600) to fifth. If there are only five (5) official starters in the stakes race, the purse shall be paid: winner 60%; place 20%; show 10%; fourth 6%; and fifth 4%. If there are less than five (5) official starters in the stakes race, the purse shall be paid in accordance with the specified percentages in the immediately preceding sentence above, and the balance of the purse for the race shall revert to the purse fund.

(b) Non-Stakes races. In all other races (*i.e.*, non-stakes races), purse distribution shall be paid: winner 60%; place 20%; show 10%; fourth 5%; and the remaining 5% shall be divided and paid equally among the other official starters in the race (*i.e.*, fifth through last). However, if there are only five (5) official starters in the non-stakes race, the purse shall be paid: winner 60%; place 20%; show 10%; fourth 6%; and fifth 4%. If there are less than five (5) official starters in the non-stakes race, the purse shall be paid in accordance with the specified percentages in the immediately preceding sentence above, and the balance of the purse for the race shall revert to the purse fund.

CLAIMING

ARC HR 2433. No money or its equivalent shall be put in the claiming box. For a claim to be valid the person making the claim must have a credit balance in his account with the franchise holder's horsemen's account of not less than the amount of the claim (plus any applicable sales tax).

All claims shall be deposited in the claiming box at least fifteen (15) minutes before the established post time of the race out of which the claim is made. Claim money must be received by the Horsemen's Bookkeeper's office one hour prior to the published post time of the race in which the claim is being made. Only cash, money order, wire transfer or cashier's check will be accepted. A 6.5% percent state sales tax, a 1.5% city sales tax and a 1.5% county tax must be paid by the person claiming the horse. No currency will be accepted with the written claim. If currency is deposited in the claim envelope, the claim will not be considered. Thoroughbred Title to a claimed horse shall be vested when the horse becomes an official starter. A horse is a starter when the stall doors of the starting gate open in front of it at a time when the starter dispatches the horses. A horse claimed shall not be delivered by the original owner until authority has been given by the racing secretary or clerk of scales.

ARC HR 2445. For a period of twenty-seven (27) days after the claim, a claimed horse shall not start in a race in which the determining eligibility price is less than twenty-five percent (25%) more than the price at which it was claimed. The day claimed shall not count for purposes of counting the applicable twenty-seven (27) day period, and for this purpose the following calendar day after the day claimed shall be the first day. The horse shall be entitled to enter whenever necessary so that the horse may start on the twenty-eighth (28th) calendar day following the claim, for any claiming price.

ARC HR 2457. Any horse claimed at Oaklawn Jockey Club will not be eligible to start at any other track until the current Oaklawn meeting is closed, unless approved by the Racing Secretary and the Stewards.

ARC HR 2458(a). Except as otherwise provided in this Rule 2458, no horse claimed during an Oaklawn race meet shall be eligible to race at another track for a period of thirty (30) days following the end of the Oaklawn racing season unless the claimed horse has subsequently run back in another race at Oaklawn following the claim.

ARC HR 2458(b). Horses claimed during the final twenty-one (21) calendar days of an Oaklawn race meet are excepted from the requirements of Rule 2458(a).

HISA Rule 2240. Veterinarians' List

- (a) A Veterinarians' List shall be maintained by the Authority of Covered Horses that are determined to be ineligible to compete in a Covered Horserace in any

- jurisdiction until released by a Regulatory Veterinarian registered with the Authority.
- (b) Covered Horses shall be placed on the Veterinarians' List until removed in accordance with Rules 2241 and 2242:
- (1) the following Covered Horses shall be placed on the Veterinarians' List by a Regulatory Veterinarian:
 - (i) Covered Horses affected by illness, physical distress, medical compromise, unsoundness, injury, Epistaxis, infirmity, heat exhaustion, or deemed unfit to race.
 - (2) Covered Horses placed on the Veterinarians' List for unsoundness, injury, or Epistaxis are prohibited from participating in a Workout for 7 days.
 - (3) The following Covered Horses shall be placed on the Veterinarians' List by the Authority:
 - (i) Covered Horses which have not started in more than 365 days;
 - (ii) unraced Covered Horses which have not made a start prior to January 1 of their 4-year-old year;
 - (iii) Covered Horses which have been administered Shock Wave Therapy;
 - (iv) Covered Horses which have been administered an intra-articular injection;
 - (v) Covered Horses which have been administered clenbuterol;
 - (vi) Covered Horses designated by the Agency; and
 - (vii) Covered Horses currently on a Veterinarian's List in any state, if trying to enter in a Covered Horserace.
- (c) The Responsible Person and the Designated Owner (as defined in Rule 1020) shall be notified in writing within 24 hours that their Covered Horse has been placed on the Veterinarians' List
- (d) Diagnostic testing may be required for any Covered Horse placed on the Veterinarians' List, at the discretion of the Regulatory Veterinarian or Association Veterinarian.

HISA Rule 2241. Duration of Stay on the Veterinarians' List

- (a) Covered Horses placed on the Veterinarians' List in accordance with Rule 2240 shall remain on the Veterinarians' List as follows:
- (1) Covered Horses placed on the Veterinarians' List for unsoundness shall remain on the list for a minimum of 14 days;
 - (2) Covered Horses placed on the Veterinarians' List two or more times for unsoundness within the previous 365 days shall remain on the Veterinarians' List for a minimum of 45 days for the second time, a minimum of 75 days for the third time, and shall be permanently barred for life from further participation in Covered Horseraces for the fourth time;
 - (3) Covered Horses placed on the Veterinarians' List for Epistaxis shall remain on the list for a minimum of 14 days;
 - (4) Covered Horses placed on the Veterinarians' List two or more times for Epistaxis within the previous 365 days shall remain on the Veterinarians' List for a minimum of 30 days for the second time, for a minimum of 180 days for the third time, and shall be permanently barred for life from further participation in Covered Horseraces for the fourth time;
 - (5) Covered Horses placed on the Veterinarians' List for illness, physical distress, medical compromise, injury, infirmity, or heat exhaustion shall remain on the list for a minimum of 7 days;
 - (6) Covered Horses treated with Shock Wave Therapy shall be placed on

- the Veterinarians' List for 30 days and are prohibited from participating in a Workout for 14 days;
- (7) Except as set forth in Rule 2271(a)(11) and Rule 2271(a)(12), Covered Horses administered any intra-articular injection(s) shall be placed on the Veterinarians' List for 14 days and are prohibited from participating in a Workout for 7 days;
 - (8) Covered Horses administered clenbuterol shall be placed on the Veterinarians' List until they have undergone a release protocol approved by the Agency; and
 - (9) if before, during, or after the workout for removal from the Veterinarians' List, the Covered Horse is deemed to be unsound or to have Epistaxis, the stay on the Veterinarians' List shall be extended an additional 30 days, and further diagnostic testing may be required as determined by the Regulatory Veterinarian.

HISA Rule 2242. Removal of Horses from the Veterinarians' List

- (a) Regulatory Veterinarians may remove Covered Horses from the Veterinarians' List in accordance with Rule 2242 and shall document such removal to the Authority.
- (b) A Covered Horse placed on the Veterinarians' List which has not started in more than 365 days or has not made a start prior to January 1 of its 4-year-old year, or has been placed on the Veterinarians' List as unsound or as having experienced Epistaxis may be removed from the Veterinarians' List upon satisfaction of paragraphs (1) through (7) below.
 - (1) the Trainer and Attending Veterinarian must observe the Covered Horse jog and submit to the Regulatory Veterinarian a co-signed statement that the Covered Horse is fit to perform a Workout. If the Covered Horse does not perform the Workout for the Regulatory Veterinarian within 7 days, the Trainer and Attending Veterinarian must observe the Covered Horse again at the jog and submit a new co-signed statement.
 - (2) any diagnostics required by the Regulatory Veterinarian who placed the Covered Horse on the Veterinarians' List must be produced by the Responsible Person, and any associated diagnostic criteria required by the Regulatory Veterinarian must be satisfied, prior to requesting permission to work the Covered Horse for removal.
 - (3) the Trainer must then apply no less than 48 hours in advance of the Workout to the Regulatory Veterinarian for permission to work the Covered Horse for removal from the Veterinarians' List.
 - (4) the Covered Horse must perform a Workout under the supervision of the Regulatory Veterinarian and demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Regulatory Veterinarian that the Covered Horse is sound to race.
 - (5) the Regulatory Veterinarian must determine, no earlier than 30 minutes or later than 2 hours after the Workout conducted pursuant to paragraph (b)(4) above, that there is no evidence or sign of Epistaxis, physical distress, medical compromise, or unsoundness.
 - (6) a blood sample shall be collected from the Covered Horse following the Workout, and in accordance with Rule 3132(e), is subject to all of the same requirements that apply to Sample collection at Covered Horseraces.
 - (7) the Regulatory Veterinarian shall communicate the determination made in paragraph (b)(5) above and the results of the testing conducted pursuant to paragraph (b)(6) above to the Regulatory Veterinarian who placed the Covered Horse on the list, or in that Regulatory Veterinarian's absence, with a Regulatory Veterinarian from the same Racetrack, who then may release the Covered Horse from the Veterinarians' List.

- (c) A Covered Horse which has not started in more than 365 days or has not made a start prior to January 1 of its 4-year-old year may perform a Workout in the presence of the Regulatory Veterinarian beginning 335 days since its last start or, if unraced, December 1st of its 3-year-old year. If the Covered Horse has not started within 60 days of being released by the Regulatory Veterinarian, the Covered Horse must fulfill the requirements in 2242(b) again.
- (d) A Covered Horse placed on the Veterinarians' List for illness, physical distress, medical compromise, injury, infirmity, or heat exhaustion may be removed from the Veterinarians' List after expiration of the applicable minimum duration set forth in Rule 2241 and sound health has been declared by the Attending Veterinarian and the Regulatory Veterinarian and documented to the Authority.

HISA Rule 2251. Veterinary Reports

- (a) All Veterinarians shall provide treatment records pursuant to Rule Series 3000. In addition to the uses set forth therein, these records may be used by Regulatory Veterinarians in the performance of their duties at the Racetrack, for transfer to the new Responsible Person of a Covered Horse, and for purposes of research conducted by the Authority in accordance with the Act to enhance the safety and welfare of racehorses. Subject to the approval of the Authority, records may also be accessed by the State Racing Commission or the Stewards.
- (b) For treatments, procedures, and surgeries performed at a location licensed by a State Racing Commission or a Training Facility, and in addition to the information required to be submitted by Veterinarians pursuant to Rule Series 3000, every Veterinarian who examines or treats a Covered Horse shall, within 24 hours after such examination or treatment, submit to the Authority the following information in an electronic format designated by the Authority:
 - (1) name and HISA ID of the Covered Horse or, if unnamed, the registered name of the dam and year of foaling;
 - (2) name and HISA ID of the Responsible Person of the Covered Horse;
 - (3) name and HISA ID of the Veterinarian;
 - (4) contact information for the Veterinarian (phone number, email address);
 - (5) any information concerning the presence of unsoundness and responses to diagnostic tests;
 - (6) diagnosis;
 - (7) condition treated;
 - (8) the name of any medication, drug, substance, or procedure administered or prescribed, including date and time of administration, dose, route of administration (including structure treated if local administration), frequency, and duration (where applicable) of treatment;
 - (9) any non-surgical procedure performed (including but not limited to diagnostic tests, imaging, and shockwave treatment) including the structures examined/treated and the date and time of the procedure;
 - (10) any surgical procedure performed including the date and time of the procedure; and
 - (11) any other information necessary to maintain and improve the health and welfare of the Covered Horse.
- (c) For treatments, procedures, and surgeries performed at a location that is not a Training Facility or is not licensed by a State Racing Commission, and in addition to the information required to be submitted by Veterinarians pursuant to Rule Series 3000, every Veterinarian who examines or treats a Covered Horse shall, within 24 hours of ambulatory care, outpatient care, or discharge from a clinic or hospital, submit to the Authority the following information in an electronic format designated by the Authority:
 - (1) name and HISA ID of the Covered Horse or, if unnamed, the registered name of the dam and year of foaling;
 - (2) name and HISA ID of the Responsible Person for the Covered Horse;

- (3) name and HISA ID of the Veterinarian;
- (4) contact information for the Veterinarian (phone number, email address);
- (5) any information concerning the presence of unsoundness;
- (6) summary of all diagnostic tests and test results;
- (7) any intra-articular diagnostic and therapeutic medications administered or prescribed, including the date and time of the treatment;
- (8) administration of Shock Wave Therapy, including the date and time of the Shock Wave Therapy; and
- (9) any surgical procedure performed including the date and time of the procedure.

HISA RULE 2252. Responsible Persons' Records

- (a) In addition to the information required to be submitted by Responsible Persons under Rule Series 3000, a Responsible Person is responsible for maintaining a record of medical, therapeutic, and surgical treatments and procedures for every Covered Horse in the Responsible Person's control.
- (b) For purposes of this Rule, the term treatment:
 - (1) means the administration of any medication or substance containing a medication to a Covered Horse by a Responsible Person or the Responsible Person's designee;
 - (2) includes the administration of medications that are prescribed by a Veterinarian but administered by the Responsible Person or the Responsible Person's designee; and
 - (3) notwithstanding Rule 3040(b)(8), specifically excludes medications or procedures directly administered by a Veterinarian or that Veterinarian's employees.
- (c) Records must include the information outlined in paragraphs (1) and (2) below.
 - (1) For medical treatments:
 - (i) name and HISA ID of the Covered Horse or, if unnamed, the registered name of the dam and year of foaling;
 - (ii) name and HISA ID of the Responsible Person;
 - (iii) generic name of the drug, or brand name if a non-generic drug is used;
 - (iv) name and HISA ID of the prescribing Veterinarian;
 - (v) date of the treatment;
 - (vi) route of administration;
 - (vii) dosage administered;
 - (viii) approximate time (to the nearest hour) of each treatment; and
 - (ix) full name and contact information of the individual who administered the treatment.
 - (2) For medical procedures, including, but not limited to, Shock Wave Therapy, physiotherapy, acupuncture, chiropractic, and surgeries:
 - (i) name and HISA ID of the Covered Horse, or, if unnamed, the registered name of the dam and year of foaling;
 - (ii) name and HISA ID of the Responsible Person;
 - (iii) diagnosis and condition being treated;
 - (iv) name of procedure or surgery;
 - (v) date of the procedure;
 - (vi) full name and contact information of the individual who administered or performed the procedure; and
 - (vii) any other information necessary to maintain and improve the health and welfare of the Covered Horse.
- (d) In addition to the uses of records set forth in the Rule Series 3000, records may be used by the Regulatory Veterinarians in the performance of their duties at the Racetrack, for transfer of medical records to the new Responsible Person of

a Covered Horse, and for purposes of research conducted by the Authority in accordance with the Act to enhance the safety and welfare of racehorses. Subject to the approval of the Authority, records may also be accessed by the State Racing Commission or the Stewards.

- (e) Nothing set forth in the rules of the Authority shall limit the Authority's access to, or use of, records submitted under any provision in the Rule 2000 Series.

HISA RULE 2253. Records for Covered Horses Shipping to the Racetrack

- (a) If a Covered Horse is not stabled at a facility under the Authority's jurisdiction for the full 30 days prior to a Race or Workout for purposes of removal from the Veterinarians' List, the Responsible Person shall obtain and maintain the following information:
- (1) name and HISA ID of the Covered Horse or, if unnamed, the registered name of the dam and year of foaling;
 - (2) generic name of the drug, or brand name of the drug if a non-generic drug is used;
 - (3) date and duration of the treatment;
 - (4) route of administration;
 - (5) dosage administered;
 - (6) surgical procedures;
 - (7) non-surgical therapies and procedures;
 - (8) daily log of exercise activities at the facility;
 - (9) daily log of treatments and procedures at the facility; and
 - (10) any other information necessary to maintain and improve the health and welfare of the Covered Horse.
- (b) In addition to the uses of records set forth in the Rules Series 3000, records may be used by the Regulatory Veterinarians in the performance of their duties at the Racetrack, for transfer of medical records to the new Responsible Person of a Covered Horse, and for purposes of research conducted by the Authority in accordance with the Act to enhance the safety and welfare of racehorses. Subject to the approval of the Authority, records may also be accessed by the State Racing Commission or the Stewards.

HISA Rule 2261. Transfer of Claimed Horse Records

- (a) Entry of Horses subject to being claimed in a Claiming Race implies consent of the Responsible Person to the transfer of the following records to the new Responsible Person of the claimed Covered Horse:
- a. all medical records required to be maintained pursuant to Rules 2252 and 2253; and
 - b. all veterinary records required to be submitted pursuant to Rule 2251.
- (b) If a Covered Horse is successfully claimed by a new Responsible Person, the previous Responsible Person must transfer the Covered Horse's medical records required to be maintained pursuant to Rule 2252 and Rule 2253 to the new Responsible Person within 3 calendar days of transfer of the claimed Covered Horse to the new Responsible Person

HISA Rule 2262. Void Claim

- (a) Except as provided in paragraphs (e) and (g), title to a Covered Horse which is claimed shall be vested in the successful claimant from the time the field has been dispatched from the starting gate and the Covered Horse becomes a starter.
- (b) All claimed Covered Horses shall go to the Test Barn, or, if approved by the Authority, the secured area used for claimed Covered Horse inspections, for observation by the Regulatory Veterinarian.
- (c) Test Barn or approved secured area observation:
- (1) upon entry into the Test Barn or approved secured area, a claimed Covered

Horse shall be periodically observed for no less than 30 minutes during the "cooling out" process, unless excused by the Regulatory Veterinarian.

- (2) a claimed Covered Horse shall be observed by the Regulatory Veterinarian at the completion of any required sample collection, or immediately before the Covered Horse is released from the Test Barn or approved secured area, to determine whether the claimed Covered Horse will be placed on the Veterinarians' List for Epistaxis, or as unsound or lame.
- (3) the minimum criteria for observation by the Regulatory Veterinarian are:
 - (i) to assess the claimed Covered Horse for signs of Epistaxis or any other concerning clinical abnormalities; and
 - (ii) to jog the claimed Covered Horse in hand in a straight line of not fewer than 5 strides moving toward and away from the Regulatory Veterinarian.
- (d) If a claimed Covered Horse is placed on the Veterinarians' List for Epistaxis, or as unsound or lame, it is the responsibility of the Regulatory Veterinarian to notify the Stewards immediately so that the Stewards may order the Claim voided.
- (e) The Claim shall be voided, and ownership of the Covered Horse retained by the original Owner, if:
 - (1) the Covered Horse dies or is euthanized before the Covered Horse is released to the claimant;
 - (2) the Covered Horse is vanned off of the racing track and placed on the Veterinarians' List for Epistaxis, or as unsound or lame; or
 - (3) the Regulatory Veterinarian determines pursuant to the observation described in Rule 2262(c)(1) that the Covered Horse will be placed on the Veterinarians' List for Epistaxis, or as unsound or lame before the Covered Horse is released to the successful claimant.
- (f) The Claim shall not be voided if, prior to the Race in which the Covered Horse is claimed, the claimant elects to claim the Covered Horse by checking the appropriate box on the claim slip regardless of whether the Regulatory Veterinarian determines the Covered Horse will be placed on the Veterinarians' List for Epistaxis or as unsound or lame.
- (g) Notwithstanding Rule 3060(a) and 3070(c), and subject to Rule 2262(h), if a postrace sample collected from a claimed Covered Horse on the day of the Claim results in an Adverse Analytical Finding, the claimant shall be promptly notified by the Agency or the Authority and the claimant shall have the option to void the claim. The claimant shall have 48 hours from notification of the Adverse Analytical Finding to void the claim by submitting in writing to the Stewards the claimant's decision to void the claim. If the claimant chooses to void the Claim:
 - (1) the claimant shall be entitled to the return from the prior Owner of all sums paid for the claimed Covered Horse;
 - (2) the claimant shall be entitled, upon submission of expense records, to recoup reasonable expenses from the prior Owner related to the care, custody and control of the Covered Horse incurred after the date of the claim; and
 - (3) the claimed Covered Horse shall be returned to the prior Owner.
- (h) A claimant shall not have the option to void a Claim pursuant to Rule 2262(g) if any of the following events have occurred since the Claim:
 - (1) the claimed Covered Horse has made a start in a Covered Horserace or race;
 - (2) the claimant failed to exercise due care in maintaining and boarding the claimed Covered Horse;
 - (3) the claimant made material alterations to the claimed Covered Horse; or
 - (4) the claimed Covered Horse dies or is euthanized.

HISA Rule 2263. Waiver Claiming Option

- (a) At time of entry into a Claiming Race an Owner or Responsible Person may opt to declare a Covered Horse ineligible to be claimed, provided:
 - (1) the Covered Horse has not started in 120 days;
 - (2) the Covered Horse's last start must have been for a claiming price; and

- (3) the Covered Horse is entered in a claiming race with a claiming price equal to or greater than the claiming price for which it last started.
- (b) A Responsible Person may opt to declare a Covered Horse ineligible to be claimed for a second consecutive race, provided:
 - (1) the waiver must have been asserted in the first race back to be eligible for the second waiver;
 - (2) if the Covered Horse wins the first race back, it is ineligible for the second waiver;
 - (3) if the Covered Horse changes majority ownership subsequent to the first race, it is ineligible for the second waiver; and
 - (4) the provisions in 2263(a)(3) still apply.

HISA Rule 2280. Use of Riding Crop

- (a) Subject to paragraphs (b) and (c) of this Rule, a Jockey who uses a riding crop on a Covered Horse during a Covered Horserace shall do so only in a professional manner consistent with maintaining focus and concentration of the Covered Horse for safety of Covered Horses and Riders, or for encouragement to achieve optimal performance.
- (b) A Jockey may:
 - (1) use the crop only on the hindquarters or the shoulders to activate and focus the Covered Horse;
 - (2) use the crop a maximum of 6 times during a race. Use of the crop shall be considered any contact of the crop with the Covered Horse except for a tap to the shoulder of the Covered Horse as permitted by Rule 2280(b)(4);
 - (3) use the crop in increments of 2 or fewer strikes. A Jockey must allow at least 2 strides for the Covered Horse to respond before using the crop again;
 - (4) tap the Covered Horse on the shoulder with the crop while both hands are holding on to the reins and both hands are touching the neck of the Covered Horse. A tap to the shoulder of a Covered Horse in accordance with the first sentence of this paragraph (4) shall not count towards the 6 permitted uses of the crop established in Rule 2280(b)(2);
 - (5) show or wave the crop to the Covered Horse without physically contacting the Covered Horse; and
 - (6) use the crop to preserve the safety of Covered Horses and Jockeys.
- (c) A Jockey shall not:
 - (1) raise the crop with the Jockey's wrist above the Jockey's helmet when using the crop;
 - (2) injure the Covered Horse with the crop or leave any physical marks, such as welts, bruises, or lacerations;
 - (3) use the crop on any part of the Covered Horse's body other than the shoulders or hindquarters;
 - (4) use the crop during the post parade or after the finish of the race other than to avoid a dangerous situation or preserve the safety of Covered Horses and Riders;
 - (5) use the crop if the Covered Horse has obtained its maximum placing;
 - (6) use the crop persistently even though the Covered Horse is showing no response;
 - (7) use a crop on a 2 year-old Covered Horse in races before April 1 of each year other than to avoid a dangerous situation or preserve the safety of Covered Horses and Riders;
 - (8) strike another horse or person with the crop; or
 - (9) strike a Covered Horse with any object other than a riding crop that conforms to the requirements established in Rule 2281.
- (d) In any Race in which a Jockey will ride without a crop, that fact shall be declared at entry, included in the official program, and an announcement of that fact shall be made over the public address system.

HISA Rule 2281. Riding Crop Specifications

- (a) Riding crops are subject to inspection by the Safety Officer, Stewards, and the clerk of scales.
- (b) All riding crops must be soft-padded.
- (c) Riding crops shall have a shaft and a flap or smooth foam cylinder and must conform to the following dimensions and construction:
 - (1) the maximum allowable weight shall be 8 ounces;
 - (2) the maximum allowable length, shall be 30 inches;
 - (3) the minimum diameter of the shaft shall be three-eighths of one inch;
 - (4) the shaft, beyond the grip, must be smooth with no protrusions or raised surface and covered by shock absorbing materials;
 - (5) there shall be no binding within 7 inches of the end of the shaft;
 - (6) the flap or smooth foam cylinder is the only allowable attachment to the shaft and must meet the following specifications:
 - (i) shall have no reinforcements;
 - (ii) shall have a maximum length beyond the shaft of one inch;
 - (iii) shall have a minimum diameter of 0.8 inches and a maximum width of 1.6 inches;
 - (iv) there shall be no other reinforcements or additions beyond the end of the shaft;
 - (v) shall be made of shock absorbing material with a compression factor of at least 5 millimeters;
 - (vi) shall be made of a waterproof, ultraviolet, and chemical resistant flap or foam material that is durable and preserves its shock absorption in use under all conditions; and
 - (vii) shall be replaced after reasonable wear and tear is visibly evident.
- (d) Riding crops shall not be altered and shall have a mark identifying the name and manufacturer of the crop.

The following riding crops are permitted for use by jockeys in Covered Horseraces:

- The GT 360 Custom Crop by RydersUp
- The SB 100 by Scott Bethke
- The EZ Strike by Alex Birzer
- The Alpha IXI by Adam Marthaler
- The Diego Crop by Diego Morales
- The Soft Crop II by Fowler Custom Crops
- The Cush Cush Riding Crop by Garrett Broussar
- The ProCush Flat Race Whip by Old Mill Saddlery

HISA Rule 2293. Equipment

(a) Helmets.

- (1) Any Rider mounted on a Covered Horse or Pony Horse anywhere on Racetrack grounds shall wear a properly secured safety helmet.
- (2) All Starting Gate Persons shall wear a properly secured safety helmet at all times while performing their duties or handling a horse.
- (3) The safety helmet may not be altered in any manner and the product marking shall not be removed or defaced.
- (4) The Stewards, or their designee, shall inspect safety helmets at the beginning of a Race Meet and randomly throughout the Race Meet.
- (5) The clerk of scales shall report to the Stewards any variances of safety helmets seen during the course of their work.
- (6) The helmet must comply with one of the following minimum safety standards or later revisions:
 - (i) American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM 1163);
 - (ii) European Standards (EN-1384 or PAS-015 or VG1);
 - (iii) Australian/New Zealand Standards (AS/NZ 3838 or ARB HS 2012); or

(iv) Snell Equestrian Standard 2001.

(b) Vests.

- (1) Any Rider mounted on a Covered Horse or Pony Horse on the Racetrack grounds must wear a properly secured safety vest.
- (2) All Starting Gate Persons shall wear a properly secured safety vest at all times while performing their duties or handling a horse. All Starting Gate Persons are required to securely attach to their safety vest one or more medical information cards describing their medical history and any conditions pertinent to emergency care, including a listing of any previous injuries, drug allergies, and current medications.
- (3) The safety vest may not be altered in any manner and the product marking shall not be removed or defaced
- (4) The Stewards shall inspect safety vests at the beginning of a Race Meet and randomly throughout the Race Meet.
- (5) The clerk of scales shall report to the Stewards any variances of safety vests seen during their course of work.
- (6) The safety vest must comply with one of the following minimum standards, as the same may be from time to time amended or revised:
 - (i) British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA):2000 Level 1;
 - (ii) iEuro Norm (EN) 13158:2000 Level 1;
 - (iii) American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) F2681-08 or F1937;
 - (iv) Shoe and Allied Trade Research Association (SATRA) Jockey Vest Document M6-3; or
 - (v) Australian Racing Board (ARB) Standard 1.1998.

JOCKEYS

Jockeys having engagements to ride must be in the jockey room by the appointed time for their day's engagements. After making weight, jockeys must not leave the jockey room until engagements for the day have been fulfilled. Immediately before mounting, jockeys must test their weights on scales provided for that purpose and upon failure to make such test will be fined or suspended. Jockeys having engagements for the day are positively forbidden in the public enclosure beneath the grandstand after 12:30 p.m. Those who violate this rule may be fined, suspended or ruled off. A jockey temporarily suspended shall not be denied admittance to the track with the exception of those under suspension for serious offenses. Every rider in a race must wear an approved riding helmet and a protective safety vest and carry an approved crop.

SCRATCHES

Horses will be scratched off the program and that deadline will be 10 a.m. the day of the race. The scratching of a horse out of an engagement for a race is irrevocable. The Stewards must approve all scratches. In a race other than Stakes, no horse shall be permitted to scratch if the number of betting interests remaining in the race number less than nine (9), unless the Stewards permit a lesser number. Where there are more requests to scratch, that if granted, would leave a field of less than nine (9) betting interests, the Stewards shall determine which entrants may be scratched and permitted to withdraw from the race.

LASIX RULE

Lasix will be permitted in all races, except for 2-year-old races, stakes races. Lasix will also be permitted, regardless of age or class of competition, during training, including Vets' List workouts.

WORKOUTS

Clockers' phone number is 501-363-4361.

The clockers and their assistants will record workouts each day, the list to be dated and signed by the clocker or assistant clocker and posted on the bulletin board in the office of the racing

secretary. Any trainer failing to cooperate with the clockers in tabulation of official workouts will be reported to the stewards for disciplinary action. Prior to a horse's workout, clockers or their assistants should be contacted and notified of the horse's name and the name of the horse's trainer.

2099.1(a)

- (3) A horse which has not started for a period of sixty (60) days or more prior to race day must have at least two (2) official published timed workouts within the previous thirty (30) days prior to race day, at least one (1) of which must be at a distance of four (4) furlongs or more. The workouts must have occurred at a pari-mutuel horse racing facility or recognized horse training facility, approved by the stewards.
- (4) A horse which has not started for a period of 180 days or more prior to a race day must have three officially published timed workouts; two of which must be within 30 days of the race and one of which must be at a distance of four (4) furlongs or more; and must also undergo a physical examination by a regulatory veterinarian and be approved in writing by the regulatory veterinarian prior to being entered in a race. The workouts must have occurred at a pari-mutuel horse racing facility or a recognized horse training facility, approved by the Stewards.
- (5) First time starters must have three (3) or more official published timed workouts within the previous sixty (60) days prior to race day, (i) two (2) of which must be within the previous thirty (30) days prior to race day, (ii) at least one (1) of which must be at a distance of four (4) furlongs or more, and (iii) at least one (1) of which must be a workout starting out of the gate within the previous forty-five (45) days prior to race day. The workouts must have occurred at a pari-mutuel horse racing facility or recognized horse training facility approved by the Stewards.

REGISTRATION AND LICENSING

Any person desiring to participate shall first procure a license from the Arkansas State Racing Commission at its discretion. All applicants for licenses and registrations to participate in racing shall be filed with the Commission on forms supplied by it. No owner shall be eligible to start a horse unless his license application is on file in the Commission office at Oaklawn **(no later than 3 p.m. the day before the race)**.

No horse shall be permitted to start that has not been fully identified. Any person attempting to establish the identity of a horse or its ownership shall be held to account, the same as the owner, and shall be subject to the same penalty in case of fraud or attempted fraud. Agents are advised to provide themselves with written authority from their employers in order to protect the interest of owners who may not be in attendance. It will be necessary for authorized agents to file a written order from the owner before any monies will be advanced to such agents on accounts of purses or deposits.

Owners must have their colors in the racing office to be registered. Registration certificates for all horses, listing their owners, must be filed in the racing secretary's office. No horse will be transferred, unless claimed at this meeting, without permission of the stewards, who will require a notarized Bill of Sale from the registered owner. All transfers of the title on horses must be recorded on the reverse side of the certificate. Any transfers not so recorded will make the horse ineligible to start, except by permission of the stewards. All transfers must be approved by the stewards.

EQUIPMENT

Permission to change equipment for racing must be secured at time of entry. All horses must race with the same equipment as in their last start. Blinker changes must be approved by starter.

HORSESHOE NOTICE

Traction devices are not permitted on **front limbs** while racing or training. Full outer rim shoes two (2) millimeters or less are permitted. Traction devices include but are not limited to: toe

grabs, bends, jar caulks, stickers, and turn downs. Horses may be shod on the **hind limbs** with toe grabs or full outer rim shoes, neither of which may exceed four (4) millimeters.

HORSES MAY RACE WITH A BAR SHOE(S) ONLY WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE STEWARDS UPON RECOMMENDATION OF THE ASSOCIATION VETERINARIAN AND MUST BE DECLARED AT TIME OF ENTRY. STAR STICKERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.

HORSEMEN'S BOOKKEEPER

It is the responsibility of the owner to provide the bookkeeper with a new W-9 each year. To comply with the IRS requirement, 28% of the purse money will be withheld until taxpayers' identification numbers are on file. To claim, money plus 9.5% sales tax must be in the correct account one hour prior to the published post time of the race in which the claim is to be made. There are forms with the bookkeeper or online at www.oaklawn.com/racing/horsemen/horsemens-bookkeeper to apply to DFA for a refund on local tax for claims. Incompass account access is available online. Contact the bookkeeper for account access information.

GENERAL

- Absolutely no **foals of 2024** will be permitted on the grounds.
- Horses scratching due to sickness or injury must have a signed veterinarian's report attached to receive consideration. Every horse must be saddled in the paddock, unless permission to saddle elsewhere is granted by stewards. Horses must be in the paddock by the time designated by the stewards. Upon going to post, all horses must parade in front of the stand in order assigned to them on the official program, and next to the rail.
- All horses must carry their weight and equipment from the paddock to the post and during the running of the race.
- Owner and trainer badges for the meeting will be issued at the Racing Commission office. If transferred to an unauthorized person, they will be taken up and the person to whom issued may be deprived privilege of the badge.
- For your protection, it is requested that you insure your horses against loss by fire. Oaklawn assumes no liability for loss of horses or equipment by fire.

LEASES

Lessor and Lessee hereby acknowledge and affirm that Oaklawn is not a party to the Lease Agreement and has no duties or obligations thereunder, including any duty or obligation to monitor the Lessor's or Lessee's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Lease Agreement. Lessor and Lessee release Oaklawn, its officers, employees and representatives, the State of Arkansas, the Arkansas Racing Commission, the stewards and all other State officers, officials, employees and representatives from any and all claims or causes of action that now exist or may exist in the future arising out of the failure of Lessor or Lessee to comply with any of the terms or conditions of the Lease Agreement. Lessor and Lessee request and acknowledge that Oaklawn, its officers, officials, employees and representatives, the State of Arkansas, the Arkansas State Racing Commission, the stewards and all other State officers, officials, employees and representatives will transact all business pertaining to participation in racing of the leased Thoroughbred horses solely with Lessee, or his duly authorized agent, including, but not limited to, payment of purses and any other monies, all matters pertaining to claiming of horses, including disbursement of claiming monies, and all other matters whatever nature. Both Lessor and Lessee must have licenses in Arkansas.

GROOMS/PONY RIDERS

All grooms should be neatly dressed when taking horses to the paddock. Pony riders taking horses to the post in the public parade must keep themselves and their mounts well groomed, their tack clean, and must wear khakis or khaki-colored jeans. No blue jeans even with chaps.

All horses must be on the grounds 72 hours in advance of the race they are entered unless they have specific permission from the Racing Secretary.

WORKER'S COMP AND GENERAL LIABILITY

All horsemen racing at Oaklawn are required to have a valid certificate of insurance for worker's compensation covering stable employees and contract jockeys in the State of Arkansas. They are also required to provide a customary certificate of liability insurance with \$1,000,000 minimum limits.

BAN ON HORSE SLAUGHTER

Any owner or trainer stabled at Oaklawn found to have directly or indirectly sold a horse for slaughter is subject to having his or her stalls permanently revoked and will not be allowed to participate at Oaklawn in any capacity.

ARKANSAS COGGINS RULE

While shipping in Arkansas, current state law requires that your horse be accompanied by a current original, true copy of a negative Coggins test along with its health certificate.

Every horse in Arkansas, (ponies included), must have a current negative Coggins test dated to have been drawn in the last year. If a change of ownership of that horse occurs, a Coggins test is required dated to have been drawn within the past 6 months. In the case of claimed horses where the Coggins test is greater than 6 months old, the new owner must acquire a new Coggins test and have it registered with the Racing Office within 7 days of the date of the claim. It is important to note, this is regardless of whether or not you intend to race the horse. The expense of the Coggins test of the claimed horse is the responsibility of the new owner. We recommend you consider renewing Coggins certification on all your livestock at the beginning of each year. This will cover you through the Oaklawn meet and help cut down on confusion for everyone.

As these laws are enforced by the State Livestock and Poultry Commission, and highway shipping inspections are done by the State Police, please be aware that failure to comply could result in detention, prosecution, or fines. If you have questions regarding the Arkansas Coggins Act, please do not hesitate to contact the Commission Veterinarian at 1-800-OAKLAWN ext. 4585.

In addition, all horses being shipped to Oaklawn must have a certificate of veterinary inspection/health certificate signed by an accredited veterinarian that meets the following criteria:

- (1) Certificate of veterinary inspection within the prior 5 Days or fewer if high risk situation dictates:
- (2) Verification of vaccination for: EEE, WEE, WNV(encephalitis), Rabies, and Tetanus Vaccination within the prior twelve (12) Months:
- (3) Verification or vaccination of influenza (EHV-1 Equine Herpes Virus) and EIV-2 (Equine Influenza Virus) administered not less than 14 days and not more than 120 days prior to entry or fewer days if a high risk situation dictates.
- (4) Verification of a negative Equine Infectious Anemia (Coggins) Test dated **May 3, 2025** or later.
- (5) Requirements for entry are subject to change without advance notice

RELEASE

It is hereby agreed that Oaklawn shall not be liable, and the owner and/or lessee of the horse ("Owner"), assumes full responsibility, and the Trainer (for himself and on behalf of the Owner and their respective agents, employees and associates) hereby releases Oaklawn from and against any and all responsibility or liability or claim for injury, death or damage to any person, horse or other property of the Owner or the Trainer, or their respective agents, employees or associates, whether by negligence of Oaklawn or otherwise on the premises of Oaklawn. The Owner specifically and distinctly assumes the responsibility for purchasing liability insurance containing contractual coverage of the agreement, with minimum limits of \$1 million, but otherwise, neither the Owner nor the undersigned shall have any obligation to indemnify Oaklawn with respect to third party claims made against Oaklawn's own negligence.

Each owner and trainer is responsible for any damage done to the physical property of the stables they occupy and agree to reimburse Oaklawn for expenses associated with the repair of any such damage(s), beyond normal wear and tear, caused by means other than a natural event. In making this application to participate in Thoroughbred racing, it is understood that an investigative report may be made whereby information is obtained through personal interviews with third parties, such as family members, business associates, financial sources, friends, neighbors, or others with whom you are acquainted. This inquiry includes information as to your character, general reputation, personal characteristics, and mode of living which may be applicable. You have the right to make a written request within a reasonable period of time for complete and accurate disclosure of additional information.

OAKLAWN SAFETY RULES AND TRAINING PROTOCOLS

- When the siren and warning lights are on, the track is closed for **TRAINING** and **ALL** horses and riders during a breeze, gallop or work out should ease/stop their horse to the best of their ability and if possible are to **EXIT** the track as safely as possible.
- Oaklawn will inform all trainers via an announcement of the track being closed and reopened.
- Outriders will radio training incidents to first responders, security and safety personnel.
- When there is a human or equine ambulance on the **TRACK**; **NO** rider or horse should proceed past or around the location of the **INCIDENT(S)**.
- **NO** cell phone use while mounted on horseback.
- Both exercise rider and trainer will be subject to fines and suspensions by order of the stewards.

TRAINING RULES

- **OUTRIDERS** are in charge of the racetrack at all times.
- All outriders, exercise riders, jockeys, trainers, assistant trainers and pony people must wear a **FASTENED** safety vest and a **FASTENED** helmet at all times while on the **TRACK**.

TRACK RULES

- **ALL** horses working or breezing should do so on the **INSIDE** portion of the track.
- **ALL** horses galloping should do so in the **MIDDLE** portion of the track; always aware of horses to the inside.
- **ALL** horses jogging should stay to the **OUTSIDE** portion of the track; always aware of horses to the inside.
- **ALL** horses backtracking, and going to the gaps, should stay to the **OUTSIDE** portion of the track.

TRAINING HOURS

Dark Days: 7 – 11:45 a.m.

- Break 1: 8:30 – 9:00 a.m.
- Workers only: 9:00 – 9:10 a.m.
- Break 2: 10:30 – 11:00 a.m.

Race Days: 7 – 10:30 a.m.

- Break: 8:30 – 9:00 a.m.
- Workers only: 9:00 – 9:10 a.m.

Training hours subject to change due to weather conditions

STABLE AREA RULES

Due to Federal EPA regulations, all horses must be bathed on the designated wash pads located around the compound. Note that this mandate means that any water that touches a horse must go into one of the wash pad drains. OAKLAWN SECURITY is mandated to strictly enforce this policy by the US Government.

Guards at the gates are instructed to admit into the stable area only properly identified persons. They will assist stable personnel in any way possible in supplying information requested. Any person wishing temporary admittance into the stable area shall state their business to the stable area supervisor who shall decide whether or not to issue each person a pass.

When the services of an employee in the stable area are terminated, the employer should return the employee's pass to the stable security office, if possible, or notify the identification office of this termination.

No dogs or fowl are allowed in the stable area.

All stable area employees must secure stable area parking stickers (A or B) for their automobiles and only park in these designated lots (A or B). Violators are subject to tow.

These stickers will not be recognized in the guest parking area. Motorcycles or scooter bikes are prohibited. The speed limit is 15 miles per hour.

The use of profane or obscene language is prohibited in the stable area or on the racing strip.

Positively no illegal gambling is allowed. No intoxicated persons are permitted in the area.

Owners and trainers who recognize any persons in the stable area for whom they consider undesirable are urged to immediately report such information to the track security office.

In case of illness or accident, please report to the stable security office.

As a safety precaution, all horses must wear halters at night.

Stables with less than 10 stalls allotted will not be allowed stalls for ponies.

Water consumption will be monitored in the stable area. All faucets must be turned off when not in use. Automatic shut-off nozzles must be used on all hoses.

FIRE SAFETY

- Heating lamps will be permitted in Oaklawn's stable area only under these conditions: Electrical cords must be approved by fire marshals. A protective screen must cover the bulb. Heat lamps must be constantly monitored by a responsible employee. When heat lamps are in use overnight, the barn location and stall where the lamp is being used must be reported to the stable gate, as well as the name of the employee who will be monitoring its use.

- **Positively no smoking is allowed under shedrows or other places where combustible material is stored.**
- No form of lighting other than electric is allowed in the stable area.
- Report all plumbing and electric defects to the stable gate.
- **Flammable liquids, or highly flammable materials** must be stored in proper containers and are subject to restrictions by the Fire Marshall.
- Parking of **automobiles or horse vans** in places other than the specified area designated for this purpose is strictly prohibited. **Fire hydrants** must be kept clear of any obstructions at all times.
- The use of fire hoses or fire equipment for any purposes other than to extinguish fires is prohibited.
- Hay and straw or any type of feed cannot be stored in stable walkways at any time.
- **Fire prevention regulations and posters** must not be obstructed from view.
- Please turn out all lights when not in use.
- It is imperative that **tack rooms** be kept **clean** at all times.
- Daily fire inspections will be made throughout the stable area by a member of the fire department. Stalls, tack rooms, etc. will be inspected for any defects or violations of the fire department regulations. Please lend what necessary assistance you can.
- In case of fire in stable area, help your fellow horseman remove his horses from the danger zone. Lend what assistance you can to the firefighters.

The **Oaklawn Jockey Club** reserves the right to inspect all quarters **at any time**.

THOROUGHBRED AFTERCARE

Oaklawn and the Arkansas HBPA have partnered to form the Arkansas Thoroughbred Retirement and Rehabilitation Foundation, Inc., a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization, in an effort to ensure quality aftercare for all Thoroughbreds that race and/or train at Oaklawn. A \$5 per start fee will be collected from each owner's account and contributed to Thoroughbred aftercare for every horse that starts at Oaklawn. Furthermore, this amount will be matched by Oaklawn and the HBPA to double the impact. Participation is optional.

RING THE BELL

The Arkansas Thoroughbred Retirement and Rehabilitation Foundation, Inc. has a bell program to raise awareness and additional funds. It invites owners or trainers to ring the bell prominently placed in the winner's circle anytime they win a race and donate a minimum of \$100 to the program.

EQUISIZER

The Exercise Wheel is open daily from the day the stable area opens until the stable area closes. To make reservations contact Paul Holthus at 501-282-5786. Payments can be made at the HBPA Office or through the Horseman's Bookkeeper.

SPECIAL NOTICE

The Rules of Racing adopted by the Arkansas State Racing Commission govern all races over the course of the Oaklawn Jockey Club. Nominations to these stakes are received only with the understanding that the entries of any person, or the transfer of any entry, may be refused with or without either notice or reason being given therefor.

The franchise holder, with permission from the Stewards, shall have the right to refuse the acceptance of any nomination to any stakes race, and to revoke any previously accepted nomination, for any reason. If a nomination is denied or revoked, all nomination fees tendered or paid with respect to the horse for its nomination for such race shall be returned to the owner of the horse whose nomination was denied or revoked.

However, denial or refusal to allow a horse to enter or start because of a race being postponed or cancelled; overflow of entries; failure to satisfy any eligibility condition; scratch by Stewards for horse's actions in paddock, during warm-up, or in starting gate (including breaking through the gate), scratch by Stewards on advice of track or state veterinarian, or scratch by Stewards for violation of any other rule, shall not be grounds for refund of any nomination fee.

No nomination will be received except upon this condition: That all disputes, claims and objections arising out of the race or with respect to the interpretation of the conditions of any stakes shall be decided by the officers of this Association, or those whom they may appoint, and their decision upon all points shall be final; provided, matters under the jurisdiction of the Arkansas Racing Commission shall be decided by the Stewards, subject to appeal to the Arkansas Racing Commission in accordance with its rules.

Oaklawn Jockey Club reserves the right to produce or exhibit still or motion pictures, radio and television programs or authorize others to make or exhibit still or motion pictures, radio and television programs of certain races and related events occurring prior and subsequent to running of said races. The acceptance of stall accommodation or making an entry in any race shall mean that the applicant (owner of horse) grants his consent to the above condition without remuneration to himself, and that that applicant has secured like consent from his jockey, trainer, groom, agents and associates connected with his racing activities, and consents upon demand to deliver to the Oaklawn Jockey Club such consent of any aforementioned persons permitting it to use and exhibit such material as provided above.

The Oaklawn Jockey Club reserves the right to start all races with or without stall gate starting machine. However, the maximum number of starters in any race shall be limited to the number of starting positions afforded by the Oaklawn Starting Gate and extensions thereof. The maximum number of starters shall further be limited by the number of horses which, in the opinion of the Stewards, considering the safety of the horses and riders, can be afforded a fair and equal start. A fully paid entry in a stakes race, when denied the opportunity of starting because the number of entries exceeds the capacity of the Oaklawn Starting Gate and extensions thereof, or other maximum number established by the Stewards as set forth above, will be entitled to a refund of nomination and/or entry box fee.

In Handicap Stakes and overnights, preference will be given to highweights. The Oaklawn Jockey Club reserves the right to cancel these stakes, or any one or more of them, at any time prior to the actual running thereof, without liability, except for the return of the nomination money, should any unforeseen conditions prevent it from holding its regular race meeting or such stake race, or if, because of inclement weather or other legitimate safety concerns, it reasonably deems the running of such race imprudent in the circumstances.

In making this application to participate in thoroughbred racing, it is understood that an investigative report may be made whereby information is obtained through personal interviews with third parties, such as family members, business associates, financial sources, friends, neighbors or others with whom you are acquainted. This inquiry includes information as to your character, general reputation, personal characteristics and mode of living, which may be applicable. You have the right to make a written request within a reasonable period of time for a complete and accurate disclosure of additional information concerning the nature and scope of the investigation.

It is hereby agreed that Oaklawn shall not be liable for, and that the owner and/or lessee of the horse ("Owner"), assumes full responsibility for, and the undersigned (for himself and on behalf of the Owner and their respective agents, employees and associates) hereby releases Oaklawn from and against any and all responsibility or liability or claim for injury, death or damage to any person, horse or other property of the Owner or the undersigned, or their respective agents, employees or associates, whether by negligence of Oaklawn or otherwise on the premises of Oaklawn.

The Owner specifically and distinctly assumes the responsibility of purchasing liability insurance containing contractual coverage of the agreement, with the minimum limits of \$1,000,000, but otherwise, neither the Owner nor the undersigned shall have any obligation to indemnify Oaklawn with respect to third party claims made against Oaklawn for Oaklawn's own negligence.
